The Social Commission began publicity campaigns last week to inform everyone about Park Tower's Annual Independence Day Picnic. One campaign was a general flyer with information about wristband availability and a discount period for guests. The other campaign was to seek 95 or so volunteers needed to put on the party with success.

The party will be in our Party Room and Deck on July 4th to synchronize with the beautiful fireworks put on by our neighbors, The Saddle and Cycle Club. The hours are 5:30-8:30 pm. Entrance is free to owners and registered residents but wristbands are required. Guests are not free but are discounted through the end-of-day July 25th. Wristbands are available, in person and via email, now through July 3rd at 10 am through Management. After that wristbands are available on July 4th at our Lobby Table, 5:30-8:00 pm. Guest wristbands via Management may be paid for with a check or added to your monthly assessment. On July 4th we will accept cash only.

New this year will be 2 food lines, in order to speed things up, that will be primarily self-serve. Also new is that volunteers who work during party hours are welcome to eat early, by reservation, 4:30-5:15.
