

Pool Rules

1. Glass and other breakable containers are PROHIBITED at all times on the pool deck and veranda area. It is a fineable offense and will be strictly enforced. Glass is allowed in a Cabana, but cannot be taken out of the cabana. If a glass or other breakable container (e.g., wine bottles) needs to be transported to or from a Cabana, it must be enclosed in a protected container, e.g., tote or bag.

2. Diving is not permitted. All swimmers must enter the pool feet first.

3. Radios, televisions, stereos, and other electronic players are allowed only at a reasonable volume so as not to disturb others.

4. Smoking is only allowed in the designated smoking area. Smokers must furnish their own ashtrays on the pool deck and veranda. It is a fineable offense to extinguish cigarettes on the pool deck surface. The surface, also known as a rubber membrane, is very costly to repair or replace.

5. Ball playing is prohibited on the pool deck or in the pool, except for toys intended for pool use. Examples of toys not intended for pool use include, but are not limited to, football, baseball, basketball, volleyball, and soccer. The pool attendant has final judgment on acceptable toys. Rollerblades, rollerskates, scooters, and skateboards are prohibited on the pool deck. Scuba tanks may be used in the pool only when pre-approved by the office and only when no other members are using the pool. Wheeled toys, frisbees, and pets are not permitted. Running is not allowed anywhere in the pool area.

6. All persons are required to wear suitable bathing attire. All persons must wear clothing, a cover-up overtheir bathing suits, and shoes while in the building. All persons dressed in wet or damp pool attire arer equired to use the service elevators.

7. Only members who have purchased a guest pass may bring guests. They are responsible for their guests and should not leave them unattended for more than 30 minutes.

8. Babysitters for residents' children must purchase a daily or seasonal membership to be admitted with those children.

9. Children under 16 must always be accompanied by an adult of at least 16 years of age at all times. Children who are not toilet trained must wear swim diapers under bathing suits if taken into the pool or pool area.

10. Pool members must present their membership card with the attendant on duty and register their children and guests upon entering.

11. An accident or injury must be handled following the Emergency Safety Plan as posted.

12. Any complaints regarding members or their guests must be brought to the pool attendant or door staff's attention.

13. Tables and chairs in the pool area cannot be reserved. Any table or chair not occupied for 60 minutes shall be deemed vacant, and any articles left will be removed by the pool attendant. Tables equipped with an umbrella or tablecloth will be considered to be occupied. Tables at the pool must not be used as footrests. Trash must be appropriately thrown into the designated containers. It is not permissible to leave umbrellas on the pool deck overnight. Plants are not allowed in the pool area or deck.

14. Use of fireworks and sparklers are prohibited in the pool area at all times.

15. Pool deck barbecue grills are for the use of pool members on a first-come, first-served basis. Grills must be turned off and cleaned after every use. If *any* grill runs low on fuel, please notify maintenance for assistance.
